His great love for the Lord drove him to seek entrance into the Christian commu-Many feared him because nity. they thought he was a spy. Yet Barnabas believed in Saul, for he saw him risk death to preach the good news. Saul found new life in Jesus Christ and with the community which proclaimed Jesus as Lord.

In order to have new life, we like Saul must live on in Jesus Christ. Christ is the vine, we are the branches. Cut off from Christ, we wither and die. Yet, if we live on, connected with Christ, we receive the nourishment we need to grow and bear fruit. One way we are able to remain in Christ is through the Church. We receive our nourishment in the form of God's word as proclaimed in Scripture, the celebration of the sacraments and the witness and support of members of the Church community.

As we receive this nourishment, we must bear good fruit. John's letter reminds us that this fruit is love which is expressed in word and deed. Others will know we are committed to the truth not through our words alone. Rather, they will know by how we live our lives and how we love one another.

The Celebration of Sacraments

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.


