Dear People of God,

The other day someone asked me to bless a rosary for a First Communicant and decried the lack of knowledge of the Rosary and the 20 Mysteries among the better part of our Catholic faithful. Perhaps we are unfamiliar with this prayer device so don't make use of it and instead use the beads as a necklace. However, the diocese here in Toledo is under the patronage of Mary, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, so allow me to refresh some and teach others about this powerful prayer device. We'll begin at the beginning and say that the Rosary was developed in the Middle Ages as a catechetical device for the people on the street who had few schools and less time to attend parish events that we do today! Tradition tells us that the fifteen mysteries with their ten Hail Mary's were chosen to 'imitate' the 150 Psalms chanted by monastic communities. That's probably a not-so-urban legend (there were few urban centers in the Middle Ages) because the mysteries offer the person doing the praying an opportunity to reflect on salvation history, not the poetic images drawn from the Psalms.

Credit is given to St. Dominic for the mysteries and the prayers. He wanted to reform the Church so that her message of salvation was better understood, lived and taught by the man and woman on the street. Life in the Middle Ages was far more challenging and dangerous than in our modern times so people were working from dawn to dusk and then worried from dusk to dawn whether the rain would come, the grain grow, the vegetables produce fruit, the trees drop enough dry wood for the fire place, and a lot more than that! Because religion might not be at the top of the priorities list of things to worry about, and worrying too much is bad for your health, the Church provided the Rosary as a means of calming fears, reducing tension, and elevating people's knowledge of Jesus and his saving acts. Thus, the Rosary has several different emotional, intellectual and spiritual, levels all working together. Over the next couple of weeks we'll take a look at some of this and perhaps renew interest in our weekly recitation of the Rosary on Tuesday evenings at 5:30.

If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.


