Dear People of God,

I began a series on the Rosary last week and wanted to continue by mentioning the verbal/ mental prayers which are used. As you might suspect (at least I hope you suspect) they are drawn from the gospels. The beginning of each mediation is nothing less than the Lord's Prayer, following the 'type' you can read in the Gospel of Matthew. It's appropriate to begin each mystery with this prayer since it's the only prayer Jesus specifically taught us. To set it in context, it's part of the much longer Sermon on the Mount which begins with the Beatitudes and then continues with Jesus' commentary on public practices of the faithful in his own era (most of which he thought were done to get attention of everyone but God). He introduces the Lord's Prayer by reminding his disciples: In your prayers, do not go babbling on like the heathen, who imagine the more they say the more likely they are to be heard. The Lord's Prayer is lean, direct and powerful so it should help us shape the meditation we do on any of the mysteries of the Rosary. The ten repeated prayers of the Hail Mary are also drawn from the gospels, although the direct quotes are from the Gospel of Luke. The first one is the Angelic greeting at the Annunciation: Hail, Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you.

This prayer is important because Mary's **yes** to the angel begins the momentous incarnation of Jesus in human history. With that introduction, the prayer then turns to humanity's response via Elizabeth when Mary comes to help with the birth of John the Baptist: Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb. What could be more important at the beginning of our relationship with Jesus than the announcement of his arrival and humanity's thankful acceptance? In fact, these are such important historic statements that they are repeated as a means of separating ourselves from the rest of time and space and focusing in on the various mysteries of the Rosary. Repetition of simple sounds or images is a human way to remove distractions and allow focus, so whoever came up with the Rosary was well aware of our human psychology! But any prayer has purpose, and the conclusion of the Hail Mary becomes an intercessory prayer, asking Mary, who we firmly believe has been assumed body and soul into heaven, to pray on our behalf now and at the hour of our death. Of course, the entire prayer is offered to God alone, so the mysteries all end with the recitation of the Glory Be to God as a reminder that the glory is in fact only God's! Up next, the twenty mysteries of God's interaction with us humans!

The Celebration of Sacraments

If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
