Dear People of God,

The Rosary consists of a number of prayers repeated over and over in order to arrest our attention form Wii, Game Boy, i-Phone and all the rest by focusing us in on the key moments of God's participation in human history. As such, it's a wonderful way to tell God thank you for giving us the gift of Jesus and then filling us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit. The Mysteries are elemental moments in salvation history which leave us awestruck and wondering at the mighty love of our God. There are twenty of them, nicely divided into four series of five. Let's look at the first, or earliest events in Jesus' life. Together these are the Joyful Mysteries as they should give us great joy at God's coming to dwell with us. Of course, they begin at the beginning and that's the instant in time when Gabriel comes to Mary and 'announces' the imminent birth of the savior. We don't hear Mary say yes, but when she does say be it done unto me according to your word, Jesus is present, our salvation in time begins. The second mystery is the visitation when Mary rushes off to help her older cousin Elizabeth get through the trying time of pregnancy. John the Baptist, although not yet born, recognizes the presence of Jesus who is himself not yet born, leading Elizabeth to cry out who am I that the mother of my savior should come to me? Go back and read chapter one of Luke's Gospel and you'll discover that this event is foretold in the angel's promise to Zechariah!

The third mystery is Christmas, the joy filled birth of Jesus in the most humble of circumstances. We mistakenly believe that this begins salvation history so the mysteries help us see the bigger picture! The fourth mystery is the presentation of the eight day old infant Jesus in a dedication ceremony at which the child is offered as a gift to God. The point of this is often missed, but it represents the necessary return to God of God's lost honor in the sin of Adam and Eve. It really does mark the roots of salvation history! Finally, the fifth mystery focuses our attention on the moment when Mary and Joseph, returning to the Temple in Jerusalem, 'find' Jesus. After the ceremonies of becoming an adult n the Hebrew world, he remains behind to do what adults do: spread the Word of God's love. We might think his going back to Nazareth in obedience to his parents leaves us nearly twenty years of quiet time, but don't be misled. Jesus is an adult and will be spreading the Word wherever he happens to be! So rather than think of this as a mere finding, think of it as Mary and Joseph, on your behalf, bringing God out of the confines of the Temple and into your life! All of these joyful mysteries should lead us to one simple conclusion: it's our turn now to proclaim the good news!

#### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick**: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.
