Dear People of God,

Pope St. John-Paul II promulgated an Apostolic Letter, Rosarium Virginae Mariae, in which he gave the Church five new "Luminous Mysteries," events along the way through Jesus' public ministry. Each of these is important not only in how it affected what Jesus was doing, but impact how we do what we do as his faithful disciples. The first of these is the Baptism of Jesus. Baptism in the beginning of our own spiritual relationship with God, so in this historic moment Jesus reminds us that even he is willing to give a sign of belonging: to you and me! The second is the *Wedding at Cana*. While this was Jesus' first miracle - and by the way an answer to a prayer request by his mother - it's also the Church's foundational rock on which the sacrament of marriage is built, pointing our thoughts to family, love and making our world a nicer place to live.

The third Luminous Mystery is the *Proclamation of* the Kingdom. All through the gospels, Jesus reminds his disciples,

his audiences and you and me that what he came to establish is only partly present in the here and now and awaits his triumphant return to be fulfilled in an eternal Kingdom of grace in union with him. That's the promise of enteral life spent in a happier place we generally call heaven. The fourth of these new mysteries in the Transfiguration of the Lord. As if to reveal the realty of his promise of eternal life, Jesus lets some of the disciples see into that Kingdom yet to come. Peter, James and John can come back to us and share what they've experienced and become witnesses to what awaits the faithful when this world comes to its end. The last of these Luminous Mysteries is the Last Supper, the gift of the Eucharist: God's Body and Blood pureed out for us on the cross and given as an eternal sign of our union with him right now. All of these new mysteries call on us to meditate on the love of a God who wants to be part of our lives from beginning to end.

### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.


