Dear People of God,

As we continue with our brief examination of the mysteries of the Rosary, our next stop is the five Sorrowful Mysteries, the key moments of Jesus' suffering and death. Notably, they are in a way a continuation of the last of the Luminous Mysteries because the Last Supper is the first part of a threeday ordeal during which Jesus gave his life for you and me so we could be saved. The first is the *agony* in the garden, Jesus' last conversation with the Father during which he says in a very human way he doesn't really want to die on the cross! We might well ask 'who would'? but Jesus completes his prayer with the words: not my will, but yours be done. Having accepted the walk to Calvary, the next of these mysteries is the Trial before Pilate. Imagine how hurt Jesus is that his own people toss him across the legal border so that a foreign court, that of Rome, can decide his fate!

Rome, however, can see through the propaganda and lies, so all Pilate wants to do is have Jesus flogged, so our next mystery focuses on the scourging at the pillar. Isn't it curious that the foreigners can't find Jesus guilty? But the locals do and when they're given the chance force Jesus to *carry the cross* on his way to the hill of crucifixion. Our meditation here focuses n the isolation of Jesus, his solitary acceptance of the final response of humanity to the sin of Adam and Eve. What love our God must have to endure this! And what Jesus endures is completed in the fifth of the sorrowful mysteries: Jesus death on the Cross. The road has come to an end. In fact, for the gospel writers, the death of Jesus was considered the end of the story and only later would the Church add the resurrection accounts. It is the cross that gives the ultimate gift of life.

The Celebration of Sacraments

The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




