Dear People of God,

For behold, I will send a savior, I will save my people!

Thus wrote prophet after prophet until the time of the Christ when John the Baptist announced that the Messiah was indeed with us. As we begin a new liturgical year, dedicated by Pope Francis as a Year of mercy, we might want to consider the nature of mercy, both as a gift of God in the person of Jesus who came to save us, to the mercy we expect from and offer to others. In the end, mercy is something undeserved, it's really a gift which does not have to be given but generally should be. The disobedience of Adam and Eve did not deserve the mercy of God, vet even before Jesus came on the scene, God was giving the gift of mercy to the original sinners and all of their descendants. We might be able to think of many examples, from the captive about to be executed who shouts have mercy, to Blind Bartimaeus whom we heard about just a couple of weeks ago, to the immigrants seeking refuge in many parts of Europe and even here in the United States. Francis has asked that all of us consider giving this gift all through the year ahead. Perhaps we are already merciful, just as we expect God to be with us. If that's the case, then let us show even greater mercy than ever before and reveal in our own actions what God reveals in all of his actions with us.

Toward that end, while Reconciliation isn't exactly mercy since it's a sacrament and far superior to ordinary mercy, we might want to undertake to celebrate non-sacramental reconciliation in our families, at work, where we shop and recreate and, if we tend to be the people who decorate the street with cast of trash, reconcile with the earth around us by taking pains to keep the world a little cleaner. Even a cigarette butt tossed out at the corner is a sign of neglect of mercy toward the earth! On the other hand. Advent is also a season of watchful waiting. We await not so much Jesus' birthday - that occurred long before any of us was born - but the second coming. Each of us should take time to consider that final arrival of Jesus in our midst when all things come rolling to an end and the new Kingdom begins. Are we prepared for that momentous event? Certainly none of us knows when it's coming, but we should all be ready should it take place tonight. Al the more reason to extend the gift of mercy to others! Watch for special year of mercy events at both Immaculate Conception and Historic St. Patrick.

### The Celebration of Sacraments

**Infant Baptism**: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

**Penance**: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

**Matrimony**: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

<u>Pastoral Care of the Sick</u>: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.




